will be in a legal strike position by June 5, 2025.

Kerry's Place management and the Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) Local 5284, representing about 200 of our **Supported Living staff in the Peel and Dufferin region**, have been in talks to negotiate a new contract for those employees.

Our team has been negotiating in good faith to reach a fair deal, with a view to long-term sustainability, and in the context of our existing financial and operational limitations.

On May 19th, CUPE chose to submit a "no-board" report to the Ontario Ministry of Labour, which means that the union will be in a legal strike position by June 5, 2025.

Kerry's Place remains committed to the bargaining process and to meeting with CUPE as much as needed to reach a new collective agreement as soon as possible.

For families in Supported Living: In anticipation of possible job action, we have a comprehensive contingency plan to ensure the continued care and support of individuals and families in Peel and Dufferin.

For families in Community Services: While our goal is to maintain uninterrupted community services, some programs may experience modifications or temporary suspensions.
