Any specific teaching of sexual behaviours must be overseen by the Clinical Department and a Registered Behaviour Analyst to ensure alignment with behavioural principles and ethical guidelines.



To meet the diverse needs of persons supported, all direct support employees receive training in sexuality education and awareness. This training equips staff to respond with confidence, sensitivity, and factual accuracy, using appropriate teaching materials.



Keeping the privacy of persons supported is of utmost importance, especially regarding their exploration of personal goals. Kerry's Place is committed to ensuring that all interactions respect the dignity and privacy of persons supported.
