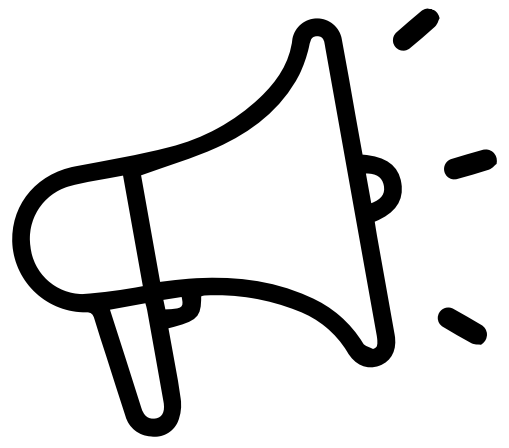


Research Participation Opportunity:

Goal - we want to understand:

- ▶ Whether our Social Story™ resource is feasible to use
- ▶ What do autistic youth and their caregivers think about it?

We are Looking For:

Autistic youth (7-18 years old)
and their **caregivers** (18+)

Child-Caregiver Pairs Must:

- ✓ Live in Canada
- ✓ Speak English
- ✓ Have, or be planning to schedule, a child vaccination appointment in ~ the next 3-6 months

Participating Involves:

- ~15 minute screening phone call
- ~10 minute consent and demographics survey
- Use ‘Getting my Vaccine’ resource for at least **1 hour** – timing will depend on the family
- 1-hour post-vaccination interview
